

Voice Video Audition Requirements

Before recording your audition make sure that your video is well lit and that you are in the frame at least from the waist up. Make sure that your performance is clear, easily heard, and not distorted.

1. Prepared Piece

Perform one memorized song of your choice. The song may be sung a cappella or with a live or recorded accompaniment. Check before you record to make sure that we can still hear your voice over the accompaniment.

2. Scales

- Major Scale – a cappella (without accompaniment)
- Natural Minor Scale – a cappella (without accompaniment)

3. Sight Reading Rhythm

Clap the following rhythm.



4. Sight Reading Singing

Sing the following melody using Solfege, numbers or syllables of your choosing.

YouTube, Vimeo, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc. Send one link of your complete audition. Check to make sure your link works and that your video is complete and streaming correctly.
